

height 100 cm (39.3700 inches)
 - We suggest you design your poster layout in the following sections:
 - Title, author, address (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
 - Introduction and Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions

- The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters.
 - The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings, charts and photos.
 - To promote your work you may like to bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
 - Poster numbers will be provided and affixed to each poster wall. Your poster number can be found on the congress website www.escmid.org/eccmid2010 under "Scientific programme" from the end of February.
 - Material to affix the posters will be provided.
 - Please strictly adhere to the mounting and removal times. If the poster has not been removed by the end of the allocated removal time, it will be disposed of by congress staff.
 - From the end of February a link can be found on the congress website to a professional **poster production service**. www.escmid.org/eccmid2010
 - An electronic version of your poster is requested for a CD-ROM which is being produced. Further details will be sent to you by Elsevier, the company in charge of this product. Your electronic poster will be available for continuous viewing throughout the entire congress.
 - Authors are requested to be present at their poster during the whole time of the poster presentation. If a presenting author withdraws an abstract after 10 February 2010, or does not present the poster in the scheduled session, a penalty will incur prohibiting the author from presenting papers at the ECCMID meetings for a period of 3 years. Those subject to this penalty will be informed in writing.
