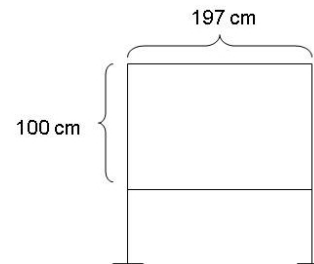
The poster numbers attached on the posterboards correspond to the programme numbers stated in the Final Programme. Material to affix the posters will be provided.

**The pre-requisite for successful posters is good visual presentation, so that your work arouses interest.**

**This can best be achieved by observing the following guidelines:**

1. Design your poster layout in the following sections:
  1. Title, author, address
  2. Introduction, Purpose and benefits
  3. Methods
  4. Results
  5. Conclusions
2. The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold typeface or similar clear lettering. When displayed, however, the letters should not be more than 15 mm high. The text should be printed in the same kind of lettering, but semi-bold and not more than 10 mm high when displayed. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters.
3. The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings and/or photos. The use of colour makes the poster more effective and attractive.
