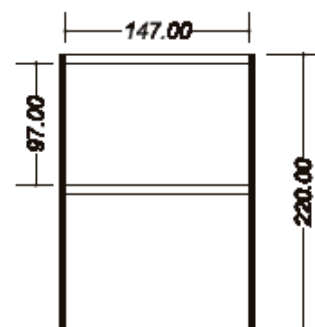
Poster Instructions

Presenters are requested to stand by their poster during the Poster Session Time allocated to them in the acceptance email.

- Max. poster measurements: **width: 147 cm x height: 97 cm (horizontal presentation)**
- We suggest you design your poster layout as follows:

- Title, author, address (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
- Abstract
- Introduction and Purpose
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions



- The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters.
- The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings, charts and photos.
- To promote your work you may like to bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
- Poster numbers will be provided and fixed at each poster wall. Your poster number can be found on the ECTRIMS website under "Scientific programme" from the middle of July www.ectrims.eu/2009
- Material to affix the posters will be provided.
- Please strictly adhere to the mounting and removal times. If the poster has not been removed by the end of the allocated removal time, it will be disposed of by congress staff.
- From the middle of July a link can be found on the congress website to a professional **poster production service** www.ectrims.eu/2009
- An electronic version of your poster is required for a CD-ROM which is being produced. Further details will be sent to you by Marathon International, the company in charge of this product. Your electronic poster will be available for continuous viewing throughout the entire congress.
