Presenters are requested to stand by their poster during the Poster Session Time allocated to them in the acceptance email.

The pre-requisite for successful posters is good visual presentation, so that your work arouses interest! This can best be achieved by observing the following guidelines:

1. Max. poster measurement is: **width: 147 cm; height: 97 cm** (horizontal presentation)
2. We suggest to design your poster in the following sections:
 - Title, author, address (on the upper edge, across the width of the whole poster)
 - Abstract
 - Introduction and Purpose
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
3. The title should be emphasised by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 – 3 meters. The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings and/or photos.
4. To promote your work, you may like to bring handouts for distribution to interested delegates.
5. Poster numbers will be provided and fixed at each poster wall. Your poster number can be found from end of April on the ENS website www.ensinfo.org under the link Next Congress: "Scientific programme"
6. Material to affix the posters will be provided.
7. From end of April a link can be found on the congress website www.ensinfo.org to a professional **poster production service**.
8. Authors must **strictly observe** the mounting and removal times. If a poster has not been removed by the end of the allocated removal time, it will be disposed of by congress staff.
9. Authors are requested to be present at their poster during the whole time of the poster presentation. If a presenting author withdraws an abstract after **7 April 2009**, or does not present the poster in the scheduled session, a penalty may incur prohibiting the author from presenting papers at the ENS meetings for a period of 3 years. Those subject to this penalty will be informed in writing.
10. **Posterwalks:** During each of the above poster sessions, chairpersons will conduct a tour of the posters promoting more detailed discussion with the authors and interested participants.
Your presence by the poster is therefore essential during the poster session.
11. If you wish to show a video/DVD at your poster, please contact the Administrative Secretariat with your technical requirements by **7 May 2009** at the latest. Please mention your abstract title, session title and presentation date when making this request.
